This week we brought out our woodwork bench. The children refined their fine motor skills by selecting thin nails, holding them carefully in place and then hammering them into blocks of wood.



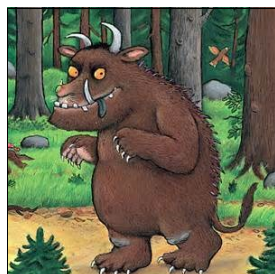
We thought about safety and wore protective goggles so splinters of wood didn't get in our eyes. We had to think carefully about how to hold the nails so we didn't hit out thumbs!
