English

In English we will continue sampling a range of Quentin Blake books and have a go at a live debate in the classroom! We will also write a postcard and an advert to try and sell an object using interesting vocabulary. In addition to these, we will think about the language of opposites and try to make sense of mixed up sentences. Can you write down a list of the opposites you know? Dark and light, hot and cold, which other ones do you know?

Maths

We will be practising doubling and halving and using this to find near doubles. E.g. if we want to work out $6 + 7$ we can use our knowledge of double $6 = 12$, then add one more (i.e. $6+6+1$)

We will also be measuring the capacity of different containers and reading scales on measuring jugs and bottles. Can you find 5 containers at home which hold liquid and find out how much they hold? This should be written on the packaging. Can you then put them in order?

Topic

This week we will be going on a short walk around our local area. When we return to the class we will be drawing a map of our route. We will also be looking at conventional maps and what they have to make sure people can understand them. If you go on a journey this week you could draw a map of your route and bring it in to show us.
