Class 3 and 4 Newsletter


Week beginning 2nd June

English

In English we are going to begin looking at stories by the same author. Our chosen author is Quentin Blake as a lot of us know him for fantastic illustrations in Roald Dahl books. We are going to read the story 'Loveykins' and write character descriptions for Augustus and Angela; the main characters. We will also write a letter to Angela explaining how she should take care of Augustus. Can you write down a list of ways pets should be looked after? This will help when writing your letter.

Maths

In maths we will be looking at different methods for subtraction. To begin with the children will use numberlines to count back then move onto empty numberlines where they can choose how big to make the jumps. E.g. 65 - 22 = 43 (take away the tens, then take away the units)



We will also be describing properties of 2d and 3d shapes and using these to write riddles. Why not write one at home for us to try to work out in class?

Topic

We will begin our new topic on journeys this week by looking at our route from home to school and thinking about forces, which will later link to types of transport.

We will be thinking about what our class idea for Dragon's Den will be and next week we will be preparing our presentation. We have had some good ideas so far - selling ice cream after school or making things to sell are just a couple.
