Project

Reading

Please try to read at home daily but you only need an adult at home to fill in your record **once a week**. Remember to bring the Reading Record into school every day so that an adult at school can also fill it in for you once a week.

We use your Reading Records to help us decide who will be the Class 5 and Class 6 Bookworms of the month so it is very important that your reading is commented on.

Spelling

Next week we will continue to explore words ending with the suffix **-ly**.

So far this term you have tried to learn 18 rather tricky words! We will keep looking at these words until half term, so continue to study them at home for five minutes every couple of days. Hopefully by October half term we will know them really well.

The spellings are:

Material, natural, experiment, pressure, separate, medicine, breath, breathe, heart, knowledge, library, sentence, question, grammar, describe, answer, address, possession.

English

Next week in English we will be starting to look at information texts. Do you have any at home? If so have a look to see how these texts are presented to the reader.

Maths

Next week in maths we will be subtracting two, three and four digit numbers using number-lines or columns.

We will continue to work on learning the 10 times table. Don't forget to learn the division facts for the times table too, e.g. $30 \div 10 = 3$ (or *how many 10s are in 30?*)

The My Maths login is: **parkgrove** and the username is: **multiply**.

If you have a problem getting onto My Maths please let us know so that we can sort it out for you. This weeks' time task needs to be completed by **Friday 3rd October**. Log on and have a go!
