## Week beginning 29th September

#### **English**

In English this week we will be looking at stories with predictable and patterned language. The children will pretend to be the animal within a jungle and use different vocabulary to describe their movements. We will write a survival guide for when stranded in the jungle, can you think of some top tips to include in your survival guide? Bring them in to share with us! We will also plan our own patterned language story thinking about our topic of pirates.

#### **Maths**

In maths we will be telling the time this week and solving problems involving time. Please practise as often as possible at home using an analogue clock. You could make a clock of your own and put on the minutes as well as the hours to help you. Ask questions like 'if it is 9 o'clock now, what time will it be in 2 hours time?'

## **Topic**

In our topic work we will learn about the infamous pirate Captain Blackbeard. What did he do? Where did he go and how did he treat his crew? Do you know any other pirate names? May be you could draw a picture of a pirate to share with the class.

We are continuing to learn about the senses in science. So far we have studied eyes and ears. This week we will be exploring our sense of smell and taste.
