English

This week we will begin to look at instruction texts. We will focus on their features and look at a range of existing instruction texts to recognise these features. We will listen carefully to instructions and give some of our own instructions using bossy language! Write instructions for making a jam sandwich; remember to include the equipment list, a picture of the finished product and the step-by-step instructions. Bring it in to show us!

Maths

In maths this week we will be looking at fractions and finding halves and quarters of shapes, then fractions of numbers. E.g. half of 12 is 6, quarter of 20 is 5. We do this by counting out the total and then sharing, which builds on the division work we have been doing. Can you find fractions of a group of objects at home? Topic
