English

In English we will be comparing different stories with fantasy settings then making up our own fantasy characters and thinking of adventures they may go on. We will also be looking at the importance of punctuation in reading and writing. When reading at home look for different punctuation marks - what do they mean? How do they help us when reading?

Maths

In maths next week we are going to look at addition and subtraction. We will think about different methods to use for finding the answers to calculations. Write some of your own addition and subtraction calculations, can you find the answers? We will also look at measuring and drawing lengths. We will pretend to be fashion designers and take accurate measurements of teddy body parts! We must remember to start at 0 on the ruler. Why don't you measure some objects at home and record them? Bring them in to share with us.

Topic

This week in our topic lesson we will be looking at photographs of different places that are either hot or cold. We will use these photos to think of things we want to find out about these places and ask question about them. We will then be using a world map to look at hot and cold places. If you have a world map or atlas at home can you find places that are always cold or always hot? Why not write a list? In Science we will be looking at animals which live in cold habitats.
