Year 1

English

Next week we will be looking closely at all our wonderful facts we know about our great city of York. We will plan an information brochure to include the invaders, tourist attractions, bar walls and York Minster. We plan to create a Minster outline to use as our template for writing.

Maths

We will continue with our 2D shape work and work out how to make each shape with the correct properties using straws. Our practical solving problems will be put to the test using dividing the class into equal groups ready for our school trip.

Topic

We will move on the Normans as part of our invaders work. In science we will investigate different types of weather and the use of symbols.

Reception

Class 2 have worked so hard again this week and produced some fabulous writing. First they finished their mini books on 'Our York', then they labelled their mini beast finding from our pond dipping with captions.

As part of our repeating pattern work we made symmetrical butterfly pictures full of 2D shapes and colours. Our estimating skills are improving using 'guess the weight'. We could test how sensible our estimates were by measuring using scales and unifix cubes.
