What are we doing next week..?

English

In English we will be creating a story. First we will look at how to plan a story, making sure that we include a clear beginning, middle and end involving at least one main character and an exciting setting. As it is Harvest Festival on Thursday we will also be completing some writing on that subject in particular. Each child now has a writing target that they should be aware of. If they can't remember what it is then do ask as they are in the front of their English books.

Maths

In maths we will be developing our methods for taking away. We will use these to work out real life problems and look at how subtraction links to addition (it is the 'inverse'). We are continuing to practise out counting in different sized steps, both forwards and backwards. Every child now has a counting target. Please ask your child what theirs is and help them practise. If they can't remember please ask as they are written in the front of their maths books.

Topic

In Geography we will be researching dinosaurs that have been found across the world

In Science we are going to be looking at how the days vary throughout the four seasons.

In Art we will be continuing our Matisse inspired pictures. They are coming along nicely!

In Music we are now focusing on learning songs for the Harvest Festival and can't wait to perform them for you all.
