What are we doing next week..?

English

In English we will be looking at an alternative version of Cinderella and then writing our own persuasive invitations to the ball. We will also be creating our own alternative characters which we will use in our writing later on.

Maths

In maths we will be continuing our multiplication work and starting to use empty numberlines to show repeated addition. We will also be learning about position and movement using language such as forwards, backwards and turns.

Topic

In PSHE we will be looking at why it is important to make up with a friend after we have fallen out with them.

In History we will be looking at a timeline of how toys have changed over the years, in particular looking at the types of material that each toy was/is made out of.

In Science we will be sorting different materials into groups depending on their characteristics. We will look a little bit at the materials used in the story of The Three Little Pigs and see if we can name any more.

In Art we will carry on looking at artist Alexander Calder and making a wire work calendar.

In PE we will be looking at how to move in straight and curved pathways then creating a short sequence to show off to the rest of the class.
