What have we been doing this week?

What are we doing next week..?

English

In English we will be reading an African story called 'The Fire Children' and doing some drama work to 'hot seat' the characters. We will also be learning about the Chinese Zodiac story to fit in with our current topic of China.

Maths

In Maths we will be spending some time continuing number sequences which will involve counting forwards and backwards in 2s, 5s, 10s, 3s and more. We will also be exploring length and using our skills to create a paper photo frame.

Other subjects

In Science we will be learning about what different animals eat and naming them as carnivores, herbivores or omnivores.

In RE we will be learning about the Eightfold Path followed by Buddhists.

In Art we will be looking at patterns inspired by the artist Lian Quan Zhen.

In PE we will be developing catching and throwing skills.
