What are we doing next week...?

English

We will be looking at a story from Kenya called 'Handa's Surprise' and acting out the story. We will also learn about the Chinese Zodiac story and perform a puppet show.

Maths

We will be learning about number sequences and practise counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. We will also be exploring length.

Science

We will be learning about what different animals eat and naming them using the groups carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.

In R.E we will be learning about the Eightfold Path followed by Buddhists.

In Art we will be looking at patterns inspired by the artist Lian Quan Zhen.

In P.E we will be developing our catching and throwing skills.

In Music we will be listening to a range of music and understanding how pieces of music can make us feel different emotions.
