Dear Parents/Carers,

We are writing to inform you that **Class 6** will be taking part in swimming lessons on **Monday afternoons, starting on Monday 4**th **March 2019.** The final swimming lesson for **Class 6** will be Monday 13th May 2019. The swimming lessons take place at Yearsley Baths and the children walk there and return to school by 3:20pm.

Currently all swimming lessons are heavily subsidised by Park Grove School and we will continue to honour this. We have split the year up equally between all Key Stage 2 Classes (taking account of training days, bank holidays etc.) to ensure that all KS2 children have the chance to swim. The children will have a minimum of 7 weeks of swimming lessons each. In order for us to run the swimming lessons this year, with the appropriate ratio of swimming coaches and teachers, we are asking for a voluntary contribution of £17 per child. Without these contributions we will be unable to offer these valuable swimming lessons to all Key Stage 2 children. If you would like to pay in smaller instalments please contact the school office.

We are sure that you will agree that this is excellent value for something so important.

Coaching is provided by trained staff at the pool. However we need some parental support to walk the children there and back, leaving at 1.20pm. If you are able to do this please indicate on the slip below. Please note there is an area where you can wait and watch the lesson.
