Topic	 Design a chocolate bar wrapper Explore where chocolate comes from Locate the continents on a globe Look at Ghana on Google Earth Discover the ingredients on your food packaging and find out where it comes from Find out what 'Fairtrade' is Speak to someone who has worked at Rowntree's chocolate factory Do some cooking/baking with cocoa products Investigate which products you can buy from Nestle

Time will be given in class for the children to talk about what they have found out and share work they have completed.

For each topic we will have an 'ignition day' to inspire and immerse the children into the topic. Topics will end with a celebration to bring together and share the work we have completed.
