Dear Parents/Carers,

We are pleased to announce we have planned a selection of workshops to ignite our new topic next term called the Victorians (All aboard). The workshops will provide the children with real life experiences of Victorian classrooms, Victorian streets, Queen Victoria's reign and so much more, and will take place at Castle Museum, York.

The workshops will run over two days, **Class 8 and 9** will visit Castle Museum on **15**th **January** and **Class 5, 6 and 7** will visit Castle Museum on **16**th **January**.
