We are writing to remind you about our book plate initiative.

If you are able to help us, we ask that you choose a book from the list selected by the children in your child's previous class and purchase it. The children selected the books on their class list and chose them because they are the books they want to borrow, share and read.

We're using SignUp.com to organise donated library books.

Here's how it works in 3 easy steps:

- 1) Click on the relevant class link to see our SignUp on SignUp.com.
- 2) Review the options listed and choose the book(s) you like and would like to purchase to donate.
- 3) Sign up! It's easy - you will NOT need to register an account or keep a password on SignUp.com.

Note: SignUp.com does not share your email address with anyone. If you prefer not to use your email address, please contact Mrs Canham or Mrs Bell via email who can sign you up manually.
