What can I do to help my child?

Encourage them to read as often as possible Remind them to complete their homework and provide them with a quiet comfortable place to do so Help them practise their spellings Make sure they have their PE kit on the correct days Ask your child what they have been learning Give them opportunities to visit the library or websites to 'read around' the topic and gather information of interest to them.
