# MESSAGE FROM MISS SAWYER

Welcome back after what we hope was a lovely Easter break.

I wanted to let you know that the DfE (Department for Education) has introduced new rules that require all mainstream schools to deliver a compulsory school week of at least 32.5 hours. This is because there is such a variation currently between schools across the country in terms of the amount of time children have access to an education. As a result, many schools are having to change their start and end of day times through a parental consultation.

We are lucky that at Park Grove we only need to make a small tweak. Instead of Early Bird being 8:45am and register being 8:55am we just need to ensure that all children are in school by 8:45am to begin their learning. Early bird will now be between 8:35am and 8:45am and registers will take place at 8:45am. This will mean very little change to yourselves or the children because children have been welcome to come in by 8:35am for some time now.

To be clear, the official start to your child's education is now 8:45am and therefore raffle tickets will not be given after this time. As always, children are welcome to come in and have an early bird session from 8:35am.

Many thanks for your support with making sure that our school is compliant with the new rules for all mainstream schools.
