Trip to Dalby Forest

Dear Parents/Carers,

As an end of year celebration we have arranged to take the whole school to Dalby Forest.

The trip will take place on **Tuesday 27th June**. We will be travelling by coach, leaving promptly at 8.50am and returning for home time.

During the trip, the children will spend time in the Forest taking part in a range of activities. Key Stage 2 will be doing Shelter Building and Orienteering and Key Stage 1 will be doing the Zog and Gruffalo Trails.

We think this will be an amazing experience for them all to have a day out with their friends!

We would welcome parent helpers for this trip but we have limited spare seats on the coach. Please let your class teacher know, via Bloomz, if you wish to come and help. Once the seats are all filled, additional adults may travel themselves and join us there if they wish.

We are asking for a contribution of £10 per child to cover the cost of the coaches, activities and an ice lolly. We prefer payment by Parent Pay but we will accept cash in a named envelope to the school office if you prefer. We have also given the option for you to 'gift another child' on Parent Pay if you wish to support a family who may struggle to pay.

If your child is in receipt of Free School Meals then the cost of this trip is already covered. Please login to Parent Pay to give consent for the trip by **Friday 16th June**. If you need any help accessing Parent Pay, please contact the school office.

The children will need to bring a packed lunch but if your child is in Reception or KS1, or in receipt of free school meals, our kitchen can provide one.
