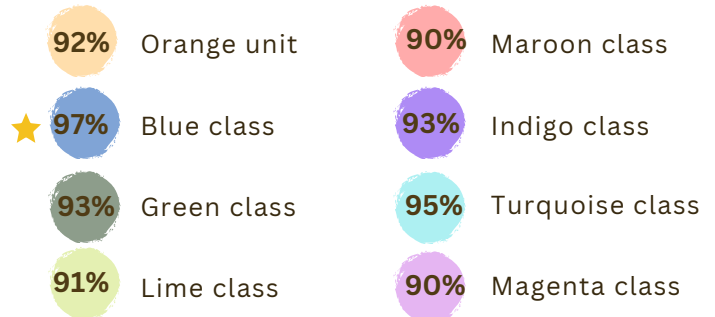

EID

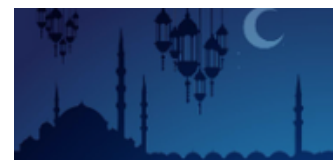
On Wednesday Muslims across the world were celebrating Eid al-Fitr - the "festival of breaking the fast".
