A MESSAGE FROM MISS SAWYER

Collection of Children From School

From 22nd April 2024 we will be changing our procedure on collecting children from school.

All children must be collected by someone aged 16 years or older. Where there is doubt over a person's age, proof of age will be required, so please bring ID.

If you are unable to collect your child from school yourself, then you must call the school office at your earliest convenience to notify us. This will then need to be followed up with a confirmation email so that we have your authorisation in writing. Once you have given permission via email for a person to collect your child, you will not be required to give email permission for that person again, but you will need to telephone the office to inform us if they are collecting.

Please do not use SeeSaw for collection arrangements as teachers are unable to check these messages during the school day.

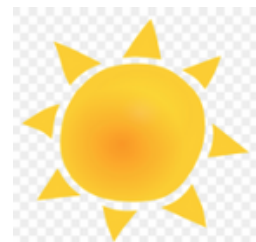
