We are very excited about our trip to the seaside next Friday (14th June)! We have decided to go to Scarborough again as the tides work out better, giving more space on the beach!

Here are a few reminders:

- We will be leaving promptly at 9am, please be in school nice and early so we can get registers done. Doors open as usual at 8.35am.
- We expect to be back for the usual home time.
- Please bring a packed lunch. Grab bags which have been ordered will be given out on the morning of the trip. These do not include a drink so please could EVERYONE bring a bottle/bottles with enough water for a whole day plus additional snacks.
- Please bring a bag to carry lunch, a bottle and towel if your child would like to paddle. Even though they will only be allowed to paddle we recommend a change of clothes as they can still get splashed and wet.
- The weather can be unpredictable so please send a sunhat and a waterproof.
- Please apply suncream before bringing your child to school as our staff are unable to do this.
- Please do not send mobile phones or money as these will not be needed. If your child brings a phone to school these can be left securely in class before we leave.
- Your child is welcome to bring buckets and spades for the beach. Please could these be named.
- We have had lots of offers of help but there are still a few spaces on the coach so please message your class teacher if you'd like to come along.
 Once the coach is full, parents are also welcome to meet us ther



During the trip the children will visit Peasholm Park and the beach. We allow them to paddle no higher than their knees in the sea and the staff/parents form a line to signal how far they can go in. The children are constantly supervised on the beach and when visiting the toilets two adults, including a staff member will always go with them.

This trip relies wholly on parental contributions to pay for the coaches. We prefer payment by ParentPay but we will accept cash in a named envelope to the school office if you prefer. We have also given the option to gift another child to support families who may be unable to pay.
