

## SUPPORTING TRANSITIONS- WHAT YOU CAN DO AT HOME.....

Supporting your child through the transition to a new class (or new school) can make a big difference in how confident and comfortable they feel. At home, you can help by talking positively about the change, listening to any worries they may have, and reminding them of times they've successfully tried something new. Keeping a consistent routine helps children feel secure, and reading books/sharing stories about starting a new class can also be helpful. It's important to reassure your child that it's normal to feel nervous and that their teachers are there to help them settle in, sharing your own experiences of starting a new job for example will help normalise the change.
