Geography

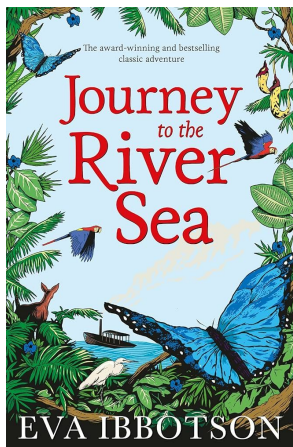
Source	The start of a river
Mouth	The place where a river enters a lake, larger river, or the ocean
Erosion	natural forces cause rocks and earth to wear away

Physical features.	Natural things that you can see all around you, like seas, mountains and rivers
Mountain formations	Types of mountains form when tectonic plates move.
