Through the Ages

Geography

Monuments	Something built in memory of a notable person or event
Grid references/ Atlas	Used to locate a particular grid square on a map (Atlas)
Climate (Y5)	The general weather over a long period of time.

History

Stone Age	A time period lasting about 2.4 million years
Bronze Age	A time period lasting 2000 years
Iron Age	A prehistoric period that followed the Bronze Age, when weapons and tools came to be made of iron.
Civilisation (Y4)	A community of people with their own language, laws and routines.
Hill Forts (Y5)	A fort built on a hill used in the Iron Age
Metalworking (Y5)	The process of shaping and manipulating metals to create useful objects, parts, and structures

Decomposition (Y4)	Break programs down into smaller parts
Debugging (Y4)	Finding errors made in an algorithm
Sequencing (Y5)	A specific set of ordered operations for a computer to perform
Programs (Y5)	A specific set of ordered operations for a computer to perform
