## **Transfer to Secondary School in September 2026**

By 31 October 2025, you will need to apply for a school place for your child to start secondary school in September 2026. The first step in this process is to attend school open evenings before making an application. The dates of the open evenings are listed below for your information. You can express up to 5 preferences and we strongly recommend that one of these schools is your catchment school, even if it is your final preference. Please note that the school your child currently attends will not be taken into consideration when prioritising applications unless this is specifically stated in that school's admissions policy or oversubscription criteria.

If applying for a school on the basis of your religion or belief, you will need to complete an additional application form and return this to the school. All applicants must apply to the local authority in which they live.

You will receive the results of your application on National Offer Day, 02 March 2026. If you are successful in obtaining a place for one of your children at a school, this does not mean that places can be guaranteed for any siblings.
