Dear Parents/Carers of Year 6 children,

To help our Year 6 children get ready for the homework expectations of secondary school, we will be sending home their CGP books each week. These books provide short and manageable practice activities that help build independence and confidence in their learning.

Children will be taking home two CGP books per week. The activities are designed as '10-minute activities', and we would not expect the children to spend more than 20- 30 minutes in total per week on the tasks set.

The CGP books were a big investment and will also be used regularly in school, so they must be brought back each week, even if the activities have not been finished. This will allow the children to use them in class and continue their learning with us.

While the homework is optional, we do encourage children to have a go. It gives them a chance to practise working more independently, as they will be expected to do in secondary school, and helps them develop good study habits.
