Trip to Yorkshire Museum

We are excited to announce our summer trip and inform you that the children will be visiting Yorkshire Museum as part of our learning about The Romans.

This action-packed day will include a Roman York workshop led by a member of the museum's learning team. During the session, the children will explore the Roman galleries to complete discovery challenges, get hands-on with real Roman artefacts like those used by soldiers or civilians, and learn through play by trying out the Roman board game.

To ensure everyone has the best experience, the classes will be split so that they are either in the museum workshop in the morning or the afternoon. When not in the workshop, the children will spend time in the Museum Gardens playing games and having their lunch.

Maroon and Lime class will attend on Wednesday 22nd April for the full day
