



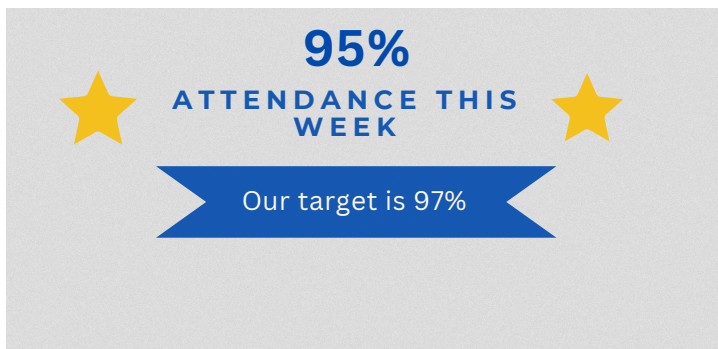

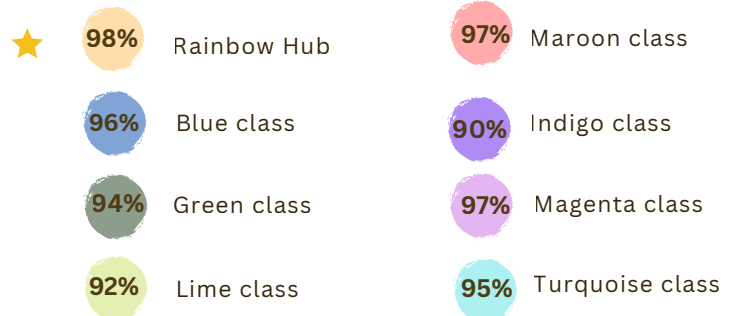
## A MESSAGE FROM MISS SAWYER
