Dear Parents and Carers of Year 6,

We are excited to announce that Year 6 will be visiting the Yorkshire Museum on **Wednesday 17th June 2026** as part of our topic. This trip will be a fantastic opportunity for the children to see real Roman history up close in our local area.

During the day, the children will take part in a guided tour of the museum galleries led by their class teacher. We will be focusing on the incredible local artefacts on display, looking at the stories of the people who lived in Eboracum and how the Roman Empire shaped the city of York.

The children will spend the first half of the day in the museum and then the second half of the day in the museum gardens playing games.

We are very mindful of the costs for Year 6 families this term, particularly with High Adventure, Crucial Crew, and our other end-of-year events approaching. Because we are running the guided tours ourselves rather than booking external museum workshops, we are able to offer this trip at no cost. Please can you all give consent via Arbor.

We will depart from school at **9:15am** and aim to return by approximately **3:00pm**. The children will need to bring a packed lunch and a water bottle, and should wear appropriate footwear as we will be walking to the museum and spending time outdoors in the gardens.
