A MESSAGE FROM MISS SAWYER

We need to inform you of an upcoming change to our school meal prices, which will take effect from September.

Due to the rising costs of food ingredients and staffing, the finance team has recommended a modest price increase of approximately 5% to ensure we can maintain the high quality of our school dinners. The new price for a pupil meal will rise from £3.00 to £3.15 per day.

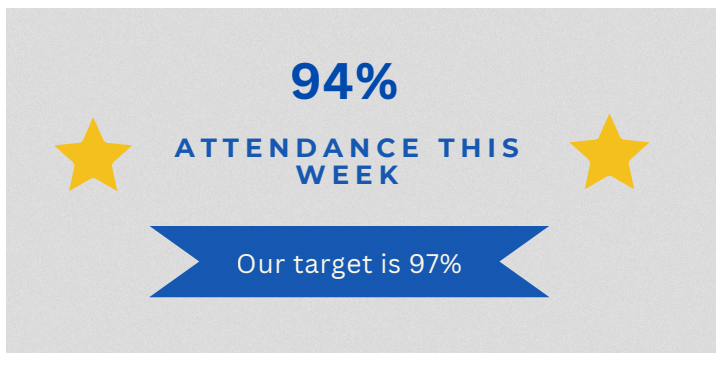
Please note that children in Reception, Year 1, and Year 2 will still receive a free meal under the universal scheme.

The government has also changed the system for free school meals, meaning you now have to reapply every year for all children. Even if your child received free meals this year, you must sign up again for the new term.
